



SkillsUSA Regions

The United States is divided into five SkillsUSA regions for two purposes:

- The election of regional vice presidents to the National Executive Council — one from each region
- Election of Board of Directors members — one from each region — provided the region has at least one state association.

- REGION 1** Maine, Vermont, New Hampshire, Massachusetts, Rhode Island, Connecticut, New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Delaware, Maryland and Washington, D.C.
- REGION 2** Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina, Georgia, Florida, Alabama, Mississippi, Louisiana, Arkansas, Tennessee, Puerto Rico and U.S. Virgin Islands
- REGION 3** Wisconsin, Michigan, Illinois, Indiana, Ohio, West Virginia and Kentucky
- REGION 4** North Dakota, South Dakota, Nebraska, Kansas, Oklahoma, Texas, Missouri, Iowa and Minnesota
- REGION 5** Washington, Oregon, California, Arizona, Nevada, Idaho, Montana, Wyoming, Colorado, Utah, New Mexico, Alaska, Hawaii, Guam and American Samoa
